Day 1 Kuala Lumpur > Auckland

You exciting holiday with New Zealand Holidays begins with a pleasant flight to Auckland. Upon arrival, you will be transfered to your accommodation.

Day 2 Auckland → Queenstown

(Breakfast, Dinner) On board your flight to Queenstown. Tucked into the shores of Lake Wakatipu and surrounded by jaded peaks, the magical feel of Queenstown hits before your plane even touches down. Take a journey through the historic Central Otago and taste some seasonal fruits at Cromwell (The Fruits Capital). Walk around the humble homes of the nearby Chinese Village in Arrowtown powerfully evokes the hardship faced by the goldminers and their families. Péople have been drawn to this region since the first Maori visited circa the 11th century. Maori were followed by farmers, gold miners and tourists. Visit the original home of commercial bungy jumping, the world's famous AJ Hackett Bungy Site above the Kawarau River.

Day 3 Queenstown - Pure Inspiration Day

Queenstown is a jewel in New Zealand's crown and a must-visit destination. A free day to explore the endless optional attraction available. Fill your days with adventures like jet boating, 4WD safari or skydiving and, when you're ready to relax, you'll find a fantastic range of eateries and bars, boutiques to browse.

Day 4 Queenstown – Milford Sound – Te Anau

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

A world heritage park with mountains, valleys, crystal clear waterways and verdant green forests stretching as far as eye can see. Visit the country's second largest lake, Lake Te Anau. Enjoy a drive of a lifetime as we travel into the heart of the Fiordland National Park with a short board walk at the Mirror Lakes. On a fine day you can see a picture perfect reflection of the Earl Mountains glisten in the water. Visit the interpretive display at Knobs Flat which details the effect of avalanches on the Milford Road and the unique fauna and wildlife to be found in the national park. Continue your journey through the breathtaking man-made Homer Tunnel which took 20 years to complete and was constructed through a world war and the depression. As we reached Milford Sound, enjoy a cruise dominated by Mitre Peak and the cascading Bowen Falls.

Day 5 Te Anau – Dunedin

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Dunedin is one of the Southern Hemisphere's best preserved Victorian and Edwardian cities. This is a region of remarkable natural beauty overlaid with a fascinating cultural history. Visit New Zealand's only castle features magnificent architecture, panoramic tower views, superb craftsmanship and scandalous history. Baldwin's Street on the slopes of Dunedin's North East Valley - it's the steepest paved street in the world and well worth climbing! Founded in 1869, visit New Zealand's oldest university - Otago University. The first official architect for New Zealand Railways, Dunedin Railway Station was built in 1904-07 in the Flemish Renaissance style and it worth a look inside to appreciate the amazina architecture.

Day 6 Dunedin - Moeraki Boulders - Mt Cook Region - Mackenzie Country (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner) On the coast 40 kilometers south of Oamaru, the Moeraki Boulders are a bizarre natural feature. Thought to be 60 million years old, these huge boulders are almost spherical and are scattered across the sandy beach like

giant marbles. The Oamaru town is also famous for its magnificent white-stone buildings. Continue our journey to Mt Cook Region bypass Omarama, a small settlement known international for its near-perfect aliding condition. Mount Cook is an incredibly scenic place of blue glacial lakes and tussock-clad hills, lorded over by Aoraki Mount Cook, Get close to the mountain with a visit to Mount Cook Village. You may want to take an optional helicopter ride-up to the glaciers and experience the thrill of snow-landing.

Day 7 Mackenzie Country – Tekapo – Christchurch

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

The Mackenzie Country is a very picturesque region with its mountain vistas and remarkable blue lakes. But the skies are equally pristine. Nestled alongside Lake Tekapo, this is a peaceful and unspoiled place. Visit The Church of Good Shepherd. This quaint stone church at the edge of Lake Tekapo is a picture-perfect whether you're looking across the lake or gazing at the mountains through the altar window. Travel north across the fertile Canterbury Plains to arrive at Christchurch. Drive through acres of well-kept parklands, gothic-style buildings and Elizabethan mansions; discover why this city is also called 'The Most English City outside England'.

Day 8 Christchurch → Rotorua

On board your flight to Rotorua. You'll smell Rotorua before you see it – a distinctive sulphur smell that identifies this is an active geothermal area. Visit Te Puia Thermal Reserve to see boiling mudpools and roaring geysers. Be fascinated at Agrodome world famous stage-show featuring sheepdog demonstration, cow milking and an introduction to the stars of sheep industry. An educational tour will bring you to the New Zealand Supreme Deer Factory. This evening, enjoy an authentic Maori Hangi (Feast) and Concert.

Day 9 Rotorua - Auckland

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Cross the Mamaku Ranges to the Waikato region, noted for dairy farming and world famous horse studs. On through Hamilton to Ngaruawahia, centre for the region's Maori people, then alongside the Waikato River before crossing the Bombay Hills to reach New Zealand's largest city – Auckland. A city four will visit the summit of Sky Tower, at 328m the tallest building in the Southern Hemisphere for superb city and harbor views, the downtown area and Waterfront Drive. Transfer to Auckland International Airport for your flight back to Kuala Lumpur bringing with you sweet memories of an enjoyable holiday with New Zealand Holidays.
