Day 1 Kuala Lumpur → New Delhi (Local dinner)

- Depart to New Delhi, the capital city of India. Upon arrival, meet and greet by local guide for an orientation drive passing through the Parliament House, Secretariat building and Qutub Minar.

Day 2 Delhi (250km) 🚗 Jaipur (Hotel breakfast/Local lunch & dinner)

- Drive to Jaipur, the Pink City of Rajasthan.
- Jaipur is also known as world's famous **Gem cutting center**. Gemstone both precious and semi-precious are brought here from all over the world, cut and polished before being re-exported. We will visit one of the showrooms, which has been in servicing the Royal family for last 500 years.

Day 3 Jaipur (Hotel breakfast/Local lunch & dinner)

- Start the day with a visit to **Amber Fort**, known for its artistic style, blending both Hindu Rajput elements. The aesthetic ambience of this formidable fort is seen with its walls on a four level layout plan, an opulent palace complex built with red sandstone and marble consisting of the "Hall of Public Audience", the "Hall of Private Audience", the "Mirror Palace" and the "Sukh Nivas". You may also experience a ride on **elephant** to the fort (subject to availability).
- An orientation drive, offering a view on a magnificent **Hawa Mahal** 📷. Its unique five-storey exterior akin to the honeycomb of the beehive with its 953 small windows decorated in latticework, with the intention of allowing royal ladies to observe everyday life in the street below.
- Entrance to the **City Palace**, an imposing blend of traditional Rajput and Mughal architecture, a vast palace complex occupying nearly one-seventh of the Pink City.
- Visit to **Jantar Mantar**, 18th century collection of architectural astronomical instruments, the largest and best preserved observatory inscribed on the World Heritage List as "an expression of the astronomical skills and cosmological concepts of the court of a scholarly prince at the end of the Mughal period".
- Entrance to the magnificent white marble **Birla Temple**, the first of the many built by the Birla family.

Day 4 Jaipur (235km) 🚗 Agra (Hotel breakfast/Local lunch & dinner)

- Travel to Agra, a city with different cultures and traditions situated on the bank of the River Yamuna.
- En-route, Visit to **Fatehpur Sikri** UNESCO World Heritage site~ the Jama Mosque. The mosque marks the phase of transition in Islamic art, as indigenous architectural elements were blend with Persian elements.
- Upon arrival Agra, visit the fascinating architecture of the **Taj Mahal** (closed on Friday), one of the Seven Wonders of the World, being awarded twice, which was built by Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his beloved wife Mumtaz. The monument made of white marble took over 22 years to finish. It is the finest example of Mughal architecture, a style that combines elements from Persian, Turkish and India a rchitectural style, and one of the UNESCO World Heritage site.

Day 5 Agra (205km) 🚗 Delhi (Hotel breakfast/Local lunch & dinner)

- Visit the crescent shaped **Agra Fort**, a monument and UNESCO World Heritage site which is the battle site during the India rebellion which ended the rule of the British East India Company in India.
- Today, a great opportunity to witness a skilled craftsman doing fine marble in lay work.
- Continue journey back to Delhi for an orientation tour to both **Old and New Delhi**. We will see the **Raj Ghat**, a memorial to Mahatma Gandhi, a black marble platform that marks the spot of Gandhi's cremation on 31 January 1948; **India Gate** 📷, the national monument and one of the largest war memorials; **Baha'i Lotus Temple**, a place of worship for the Baha'i community built in the shape of lotus flower.

Day 6 Delhi → Kuala Lumpur (Hotel breakfast/Local dinner)

- Morning, proceed to visit **Akshardham Temple**, a unique complex that combines art, architecture, education, research, exhibitions and devotion at one place. This Temple is built in traditional India architecture style from 6000 metric tons of ling lasting pink sandstone from Rajasthan and carved by expert artists from Bangladesh.
- If time permits, will do some shopping in the local boutiques.

7天5晚 印度金三角之旅

(新德里/斋浦尔/阿格拉)

第一天 吉隆坡 → 新德里 (晚餐)

集合于吉隆坡国际机场, 乘搭国际航班飞往新德里。抵达机场后, 开始游览欧洲风味及印度式建筑的总统府, 现代德里的象征国会大楼, 中央的政府大道更酷似巴黎的香榭丽舍大道。晚餐后和送往入住酒店休息。

第二天 新德里(250公里) ⇄ 斋浦尔(早/午/晚)

前往拉贾斯坦邦的粉红之城-斋浦尔。抵达后, 参观近 500 年的皇室之一, 被称为世界著名的宝石中心及来自世界各地的珍贵宝石。随后, 可到当地手工艺品购物。

第三天 斋浦尔 (早/午/晚餐)

早餐后, 前往游览**琥珀堡** ~ 位于斋浦尔旧都的一座能俯视全城的山丘, 是印度古代藩王于 1592 年建立而成。此外, 可骑乘大象上山顶参观(视情况而定)。游毕, 续往游览位于旧城中心, 印度保存得最为完好的古迹之**城市宫殿**。馆内收藏着昔日珍贵的双轮战车, 装着印度恒河圣水水瓮及陈列着历代马哈拉加的服饰、乐器、武器及各种印度器皿等。随着参观**简塔曼塔天文台**, 建于十八世纪初是观测天象之地方, 仪器精密准确, 定能令阁下对天文加深了解。续参观印度庙—**比得拉庙**和  **风之宫殿** ~ 是斋浦尔的重要地标由红砂石筑成的高墙, 当时宫中女子不可随便进出皇宫而这道墙便能让她们从 953 个窗户中观看城内的风景而不用抛头露面。

第四天 斋浦尔(235公里) ⇄ 阿格拉(早/午/晚餐)

早餐后, 驱车前往阿格拉, 位于河亚穆纳河文化传统的城市。沿途中前往游览**法特普希克里** (胜利之城), 由阿克巴皇帝建造于 16 世纪后半期, 作为莫卧儿帝国的首都仅 10 年左右。该城古迹和寺院的建筑风格十分统一, 城内的**贾玛清真寺**是印度最大的清真寺之一。抵达后, 前往**泰姬玛哈陵之都**, 参观这世界著名的七大奇迹之一, 是蒙末尔王朝第五代皇帝沙迦罕王为纪念他的爱妻泰姬王妃, 全部使用白色大理石和宝石镶嵌, 花费 22 年时间建成的泰姬陵。至今依然保留着她昔日的神采。

第五天 阿格拉(205公里) ⇄ 新德里 (早/午/晚餐)

今天, 前往**阿格拉红堡**, 有着四百多年的历史, 高达 20 多米的城墙的雄伟建筑。是以前统一印度的蒙末尔王朝皇帝的宫殿, 全部用红色沙石筑成, 上面布满了精美的艺术雕刻至今清晰可见, 它呈现了蒙兀儿朝代的兴盛发达。途径将会观赏到有欧洲风味及印度式建筑的总统府, 现代德里的象征国会大楼, 中央的政府大道更酷似巴黎的香榭丽舍大道。告别阿格拉往新德里。参观**印度门**外形极像法国的凯旋门, 又名印度战士纪念碑。被称为第二个悉尼歌剧院的**莲花庙**, 外层用白色大理石贴面, 通体雪白, 纯洁无暇。

第六天 新德里 → 吉隆坡(早/晚餐)

早餐后, 开始参观**阿萨哈密神殿**, 它是一个非常独特而且中综合了美术, 建筑设计, 教育, 研究, 展览于齐集一个地方。如时间充分, 将前往当地专卖店。接着乘搭豪华客机飞往吉隆坡。

第七天 抵搭吉隆坡, 结束了这次丰富旅程。
